Prestigious Awards Program Recognizes Top Women Entrepreneurs

"Nearly every company represented on this list had significantly increased its revenues in the past year, despite the economic downturn," she explained. "Many had huge increases in revenues — double, or even quadruple, increases. Each winner also demonstrated a track record of community leadership and the important component of mentoring other women in business or being role models for girls who aspire to be entrepreneurs."
